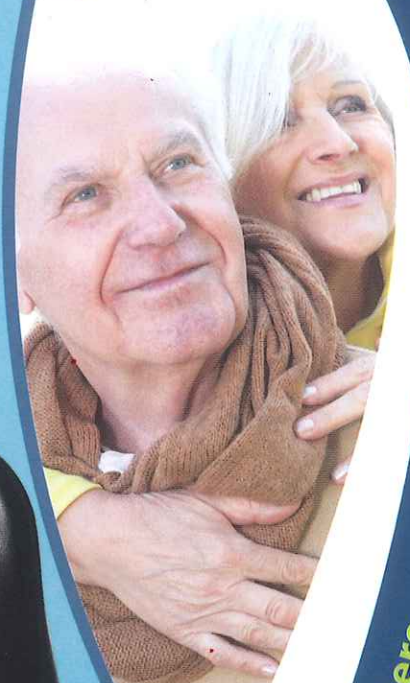

A versatile GPS alarm for anyone and everyone

Mindme Alarm is a small personal alarm backed by Mindme's 24/7 Response Centre and is suitable for anyone who spends time alone - at home, at work or out and about.

GPS and Mobile Phone network

The device incorporates GPS and uses the mobile phone network to send Mindme's Response Centre an accurate location and allows a two-way conversation.

Mindme also has the latest GPRS technology and a multi-network SIM is used to ensure that so long as a mobile network exists the device will always stay connected.

Mindme Response Centre

With one push of the button an operator in Mindme's Response Centre will answer the call. Your location will appear on their monitor and you can talk to them. The operators are highly trained and experienced in answering calls for help from people who have had an accident, feel unwell or otherwise need help.

Mindme outsources its response centre to Chichester Careline which has been established for 25 years and is trusted and respected by all the emergency services.

- Sends a low battery warning by e-mail or text message.
- Uses a multi-network SIM chip, connects to all mobile networks.
- Two way conversation ensures the right help is available quickly.

Mindme Locate

Mindme Locate has been designed to find people who wander, because they have dementia or learning difficulties.

The design is simple

With no confusing lights, buttons or on off switch, the unit is small and light and it can be worn around the neck, can be put on a keyring or just put in a pocket.

Locating is simple

Using Google maps, a carer can look up the location of the user on Mindme's website at any time. Locations are updated around every four minutes and the device can be used throughout the world.

In an emergency

Carers can call Mindme's Response Centre, which is staffed by highly trained operators who understand the challenges of caring for people with dementia or mental impairment. They will locate the wearer and help organise somebody to collect them.

Mindme Locate has a proven track record of finding people with dementia, using satellites, **Locate** is accurate to around ten metres, giving carers peace of mind and users more freedom.
